

Dear Gertrude and Marie,

Here's the agenda for the Lock-In. The cost for the Lock-In is 7KD per girl who is staying for the Horse Riding (and care and feeding) portion. The cost for the art supplies, pizza, juice, etc. (i.e., the activities and supplies needed before 8:00 pm) is 3KD. However, the LTC is subsidizing this event at 3KD per girl, so if the girls leave at 8:00, they will not need to pay anything.

For those girls who are staying overnight, Sarah and I have different break-downs for payment. I'm asking each of my girls to bring 3KD and the troop is paying the remaining 4KD. I think Sarah is asking her girls to bring 2KD and her troop is paying 5KD. It's up to you how you want to pay for the girls.

PERMISSION SLIP AND 3KD
You will need to arrange transportation for your girls.

You can meet us at ASK at 3:00 or at the Arabian Equestrian Center at 3:30. Here are directions to the Center:

Exit Fahaheel Expressway (Hwy 30) at 208 and drive west (away from the Gulf). Turn left at the first light. Turn left at the second light. Follow the road down, around the curve, and take the first U-turn. About 200 meters short of the light at which you took the second left turn, you'll see a place to drive up onto the curb. If you're really observant, you'll be able to see a bent metal post where there was once a road sign. (We plan to tie balloons onto this post). Right before that is where you need to "turn right" onto the curb. Drive across the sand to the facility which has (if I remember correctly) a white- and/or green- posted fence around it.
