

KGGA event – Thu. March 11, 2004 9:00 AM-2:00 PM
Kuwait National Guard Officer's Club – Mesilla Beach

I've received a fax from KGGA with more information about the event this weekend. The "camping" event will be at the Kuwait National Guard Officer's Club in Mesilla Beach. Map to follow, hopefully. I hear it's near Mesilla Beach but was told it's "before" the Mesilla Beach Club. The event will run from 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM.

Laurel has track practice so she and I plan to go a little late. I will meet girls who wish to go at 11:00 AM at the ASK high school gate and leave within minutes of that time.

If someone else can drive earlier, it's possible we would have girls there earlier as well.

Here are the events, as best I can decipher them. I'm not saying that girls each need to bring the items listed (although you might call me if you have some, in case I find we should bring them and can't come up with these things – still asking questions and looking for someone who speaks better English). I just put down the items on their list so that it would help you see what they might be going to do at each station. Plus, maybe I'm wrong about what we'll be doing, so if you see the list, maybe you can figure it out:

1 – at the Guide Field – perhaps some sort of macramé? We are asked to bring sticks of various lengths and thicknesses, various ropes, beads, loops (? What's this I wonder) and scissors, if we have them. I wonder if this could be making hammocks like the ones they had at Thinking Day? Or a macramé hanging?

2 – Technical workshop – I think they are decorating Kleenex boxes or some other item. Perhaps to give to patients at a hospital? We're suppose to bring, if we can, wrapping paper, glue, scissors, colored paper, jute, canvas, scraps of paper, socks, colored bands, dry flowers, empty canes (cans?), tissue box, stapler

3 – Workshop to Prepare Padge (???) – Making something else, some sort of craft – not sure what. Needed jute, glue, scrap of paper, white plates, cork, scissors, t-shirt, threads, needle, clip, colored bands, paints for glass and textiles

4 – Discovering and Searching – I think this is a treasure hunt of sorts. This one says:

"There is a map in front of you. Try to follow the arrows carefully to reach the place and look for the letter and if you find it apply the instruction." Also mentions supplies of different sized sticks, glue, cork, red paint spray, scissors, different kind of rope, stapler.

5 – Training workshop for Squash Game and Shooting Game – She did tell me not to bring anything for this one. I understood that much. I can tell it's sort of sports oriented, but don't really know much more. Must be some sort of game. It says:

"Dear Girl Guides, Practice sport is so necessary for human life and for all ages. Try to choose the suitable one."

6 – Workshop for Outdoor Cooking – I also know we don't need to bring anything for this one. This is where we eat lunch, I think. It says:

"Dear Girl Guides, Prepare a suitable meal for participants' ages. Required tool: meat, chicken, prawns, fish, cucumber, tomato, fruit, toast, charcoal, cooker, oil, bread, matches and whatever necessary for preparing a meal for four persons."
