Jobs for Girls

Name Tags: We need a mature girl (or two) to take over the job of getting all the name tags prepared for this event. This requires more than you think.

Swaps: We have an idea for swaps made with beads and a safety pin. All supplies have been purchased. We need your time.

Set-up: An energetic team of girls could work with Mrs. Smith (P.E. Teacher at ASK) to help set up the courses.

Anyone interested in leading the cooperative games stations or the water games.

Each leader will be asked to bring four water balloons (filled) for each girl attending.

Volunteer to lead a Station

Sports Day 2000 is going to be a great afternoon of fun and laughter. We need several people to run each of the following stations:

Animal Moves - Brownies/Daisies 2:20-2:40 (3 volunteers)
Bean Bag Toss - Brownies/Daisies 2:40-3:00 (3 volunteers)
WATER BREAK FOR ALL 3:00 - 3:15
Cooperative Games - All 3:15-3:00 several girls
Water Games - All 3:30-4:00 4 volunteers

During the Animal Moves station the girls will follow a leader who moves like an animal. The bean bag toss consists of tossing the bean bag back and forth and walking with it on your head, under your chin, between the knees. During the Cooperative games the girls will play games from around the world. The water games will be water balloon toss and Drip, Drip, Drop (Duck, Duck, Goose).

Obstacle Course and Relay Races

The Juniors and Cadettes/eniors will be working a little harder than the Brownies and Daisies and we need more volunteers for these stations:

Relay Races: Juniors/Cadettes/Seniors 2:20-2:40 (4 volunteers)

Obstacle Course: Juniors/Cadettes/Seniors 2:40-3:00
(6-8 volunteers at a minimum)

Mrs. Smith (P.E. teacher at ASK) is going to run the obstacle course but needs volunteers at every new obstacle during the course. She also need help with setting up the course. This would be an excellent activity for some dads to get involved in.

You will need to have permission slips and medical forms available at registration.
